TRAFFIC AMNESTY PROGRAM TO EXPIRE

On June 24, 2015, Governor Brown signed into law a one-time amnesty program for unpaid traffic and non-traffic infraction tickets. The Superior Court of California, County of Tulare, is participating in the state-mandated program that is set to **expire March 31, 2017**.

Individuals with unpaid tickets whose fines were originally due to be paid or had a court date on or before January 1, 2013, are eligible to have their debt reduced by 50 or 80 percent, depending on income and may have their license reinstated.

Individuals who are currently making payments for unpaid tickets both before and after January 1, 2013, are eligible to have their driver's license reinstated but are NOT eligible for a reduction in the amount owed.

Parking tickets, driving under the influence (DUI), and reckless driving cases are NOT eligible for participation.

Individuals must take advantage of the program by contacting the court before it expires.
